Method of correction used: A verbally stern tone saying "no", or a reminder of "gentle" by the cats is all she needs. She always stops, and usually sits and makes eye contact to see what is expected. Very willing to please.

A really cute thing he/she does is: She follows us around and is very inquisitive, almost like she would help with whatever you are doing if she could 😊 She remembers her training from prison and will readily sit - very trainable!

HOUSE MANNERS

Plays well with others (children, small dogs, cats etc.): Cat safe, prison report says small dog safe, haven't seen with kids but she is so gentle I would expect her to be great with kids.

Potty habits (how asks to go out, any problems, times etc): No accidents! We let them out right away when we get up at 6:30am, at lunch, when we get home around 6pm, and right before bed around 11pm. She is crated from 8am-noon, and 1pm until around 6pm.

Obeys house rules (furniture, garbage, doors, counters, etc.): She is so polite and has not even tried to get on furniture or counters. She follows our girls' lead and has learned good habits like waiting at doors and for her food bowl/.

SLEEPING HABITS

Bedtime/wakeup time: 6:30am

Crated (when, how long, feelings about crate): Crates easily. She is crated from 8am-noon, and 1pm until around 6pm. I don't think it would be absolutely

necessary.

Where sleeps at night: She sleeps in our bedroom uncrated with our 2 greys.

Enjoys: She likes toys and walks - she does not pull! She is becoming a playful girl - her new parents will be rewarded with seeing her personality really open up. She has cute expressions and leans in for hugs. She is young but calm.

Temperament (shy, outgoing, confident, dependent etc.): She is not dominant or submissive - she is really balanced. She loves being with people but is not pushy or jumpy. At Meet and Greets I think she has been overlooked because she takes it all in and waits for people to approach her - she is a terrific dog that has been overlooked!!!
