HOUSE MANNERS

SLEEPING HABITS

Bedtime/wakeup time: 6:30, wakes at 6 and I tell her to lay down and she does. Sleeps on a dog bed in our room with our girls muzzled at night only "just in case" since we aren't watching her then.

Crated(when, how long, feelings about crate): Crated 8am - noon, 1pm - 5:30. Goes right in and settles down. It is necessary because she sometimes turns things into toys that she finds ☺

Where has the dog been living during the day? She is out in any time we are not at work. Sleeps on the dog bed near our 2 or plays with toys or likes cuddles.

PSYCHOLOGICAL

Enjoys: Being talked to - loves this! Petting and cuddles. Playing in the yard with the others. Loves special walks and NO pulling!!!!

Fears: She is timid toward some people. Not afraid of storms at all.
